

STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE


Our page gauge is an ideal method for measuring the feet of little ones that can stand on their own. The simple instructions below make it a walk in the park. Please read through them carefully.

This measuring guide is all you require to get the perfect fit but be sure to check the actual fit of the shoes once you receive them.

1. Printing the size page



Please check that when you print this page you don't use the "fit to page" option, the page must always be printed 100%. When printed use a ruler to check the scale is correct.




2. Using the width measure

Cut along the dotted line on the gauge to use the width tape. See on the diagram where this should be placed to achieve the best results when taking measurements.



3. Position the chart on a hard surface

Stand your child on the page which is positioned on a hard, flat, non-cushioned surface



4. Position your child's foot correctly on the chart.

Place one foot at a time onto the paper gauge and make sure the back of the heel sits on the thick line (see diagram). Ensure your child is standing normally and weight-bearing on the foot.



5. Length Measurement

Make a note of the length of the foot by marking on the sheet, write down the length in millimetres for the foot. Repeat this process for the other foot.



6. Circumference Measurement

We need a circumference of the widest part of the ball of the foot so position the paper cut off tape around the foot as shown.



7. Measuring the Width


Stand your child on the paper tape and take a measurement of the widest part of the foot, again this will be diagonally across the foot at the same point where you took the circumference.



8. Getting the correct size
